Also covered in the presentation will be NARA's online resources, the Archival Research Catalog (ARC) and Access to Archival Databases (AAD). NARA is a major resource for your genealogical research.

Mr. Thompson has been employed with the National Archives and Records Administration-Pacific Region since 1995. As an archivist, he is responsible for the accessioning, preservation, arrangement, and description of historically valuable records created by the Federal government.
